Thank you once again for your understanding during this challenging time.

Our staff have been working hard to prepare for learning from home. We appreciate the access to devices and internet differs for everyone and respect family preferences about use of devices.

Our learning from home plan involves teachers communicating with students and families through email. We will send home learning for the rest of this week to the students' email. Information for how to access the students' email will be sent to the parent/carer's email addresses that we have on our system.

We will also have a hardcopy of home learning for students if they choose this option. These are available for collection here at school. We will let families know about future hardcopy packs as they are developed through our normal communication channels as they are developed.

These learning packs will be available from the front stairs of the school from 9:30am to 3pm tomorrow.

We appreciate that many parents will be working from home, caring for younger children or extended family and fulfilling a whole range of other commitments while supervising children. All of these things could make supporting your child to work from home even more of a challenge. We want to assure you that there is no pressure from our school for your child to complete any part of this learning pack or the online learning activities. Teachers will be working hard to create more learning from home for next week and the final week of the term. When these are ready we will let you know through our normal communication channels.
