## SCHOOL SWIMMING

Last week students from Year 2 to Year 6 were given School swimming notes. School swimming is for students who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills. Those



unable to swim 25metres confidently unaided in deep water, are eligible to participate in the School Swimming and Water Safety Program. Instruction will take place at Cobargo Pool. The Program will continue daily for two weeks from Monday, 3 December to Friday, 14 December, departing school at 1pm and returning before 3:15pm. There will be no charge for instruction. The total cost for transport and pool entry for the 10 day scheme is \$90. The cost for students with a season pass to Cobargo Pool is \$60.
