Thank you to all the families that took part in our canteen survey recently. The results showed that most people use the canteen as a treat for their child/ren and that overall they are satisfied with the food provided. This is great to hear. There were a number of good suggestions and the ones that were suggested by more than one family were:

- including sushi on the menu which Vanessa has now implemented and bringing back home made sausage rolls. This great suggestion needs parental help to implement. We require volunteers to come to the canteen for regular cook ups. If you are available to help, please let Vanessa know your availability (days and times) and we can work out the timing. -remove all items with salt, fat or sugar, eg marshmallows, icy poles, chips, banana pops, junk food, processed food etc. This suggestion is very valid in that we all want our children to eat healthily. While promoting healthy eating is a high priority for our P&C, we also realise the importance of providing different options in our canteen. These options include a balance of 'every day food' and 'sometimes food' that families can choose to buy on canteen days. -add more fresh food, eg school garden vegies, seasonal fruit and organic produce.
