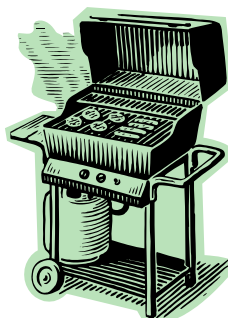
The P&C in conjunction with Neilson's Mitre 10 are having a Christmas raffle.
