Our teaching staff and permanent SASS staff have already completed 16 hours of professional development throughout the year in lieu of the two staff development days at the end of Term 4. This professional learning includes CPR, anaphylaxis & first aid training for all staff and teaching staff competing 14 hours of mathematics professional learning to support programming and differentiation. Some of our SASS staff have also completed further training in online tools, child protection and supporting our school community through an 'Accidental Counsellor' course. Completing this professional learning throughout the year rather than at the end of Term 4 allows us to implement our learning and use these skills straight away which benefits our school in the long term.

This event is a chance to recognise the amazing contributions made by people of all different abilities, to help break down disability barriers and celebrate abilities. The colours for IDPWD are blue and orange and we would like to ask all students to dress in one or both of these colours to recognise the day. The colour blue symbolises support for the dignity, rights and well-being of people with disability and the orange symbolises the inclusion of people with disability in all aspects of political, social, economic and cultural life. Students will also be completing special activities in the classroom on this day.
