Yesterday we practiced an evacuation drill during lunchtime. We are so proud of the sensible and responsible way that our students assembled in the evacuation area quickly and calmly. Completing drills allows us to rehearse what we would do in a real emergency and judging by the way that our whole school was assembled in under 3 minutes, we are confident that we all know what to do to stay safe.

The last day of Term 4 for students is Friday, 15 December and we have plenty of fantastic school events coming up between now and then. At the end of Term 4, there are two staff development days allocated for professional learning for teachers on Monday 18 and Tuesday 19 December. As we did last year, our teaching staff have already completed the equivalent time (4 half days) of professional learning to allow us to make the most of this time throughout the year. We have completed 3.5 hours of CPR, Emergency Care & Anaphylaxis training; Two 3.5 hour session around developing our 2018 – 2020 school plan. By taking advantage of training and learning time throughout the year, our staff have maximised these opportunities in a way that would not be possible in the final week of the year. 
